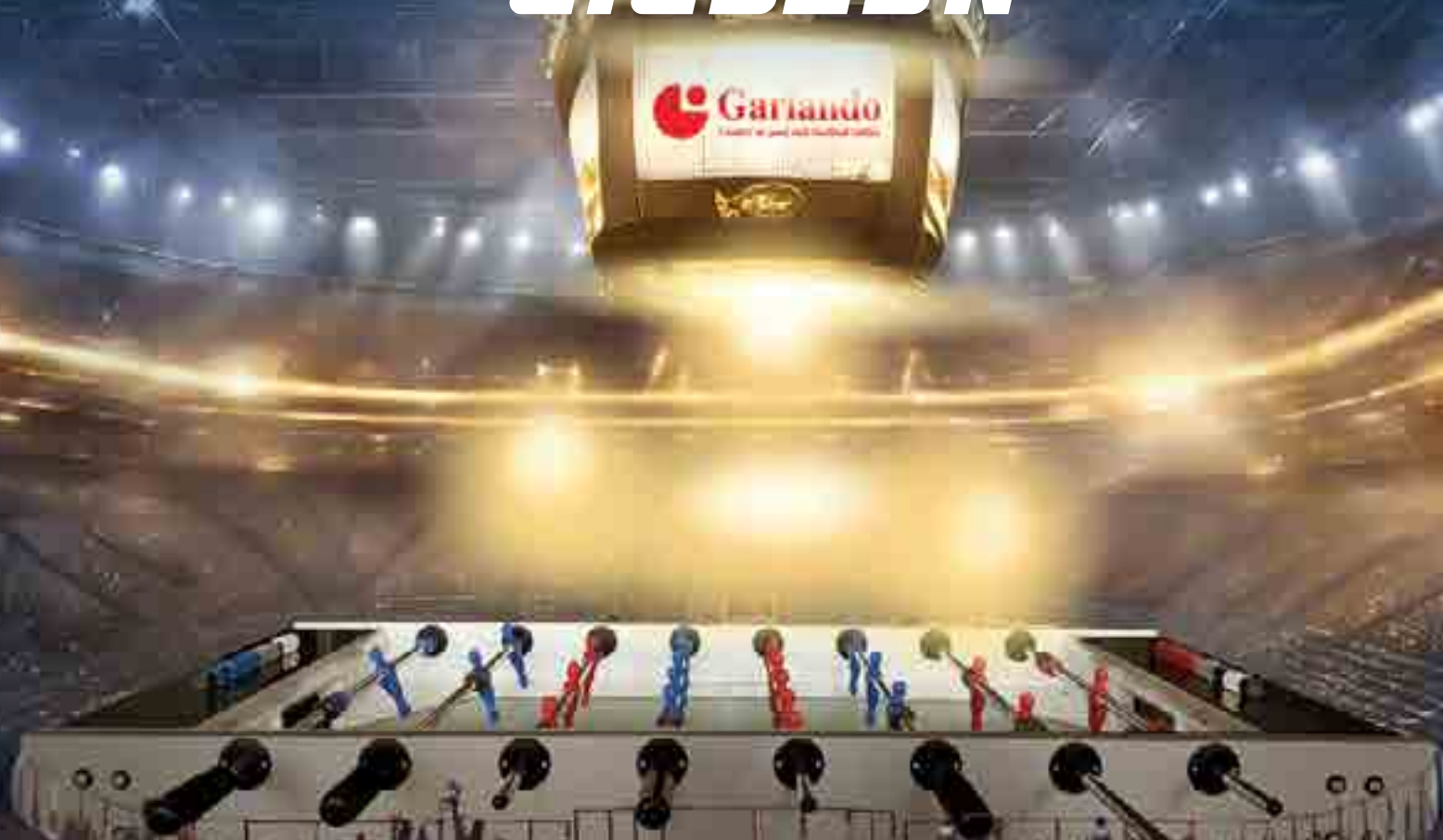

NEW IN NATIONS EVENT

A National Federation may register a second national team in the Men's and Women's categories composed exclusively of U23 players. The primary team may include players of any eligible age, while the additional team must consist only of players aged 16 to 22 at the time of the event.

ALL COMPETITION ARE 100% PAYOUT

JUNIORS/SENIORS/WOMEN: must choose between Junior or Men/Open/Women categories. Women cannot choose to play Men category.

JUNIORS U13: are only allowed to play in the first category above their age limit (U16)

JUNIORS U16: are allowed to play in a category above their age limit. (U19 or Open/Men)

GIRLS are allowed to choose between Women, Girls and Junior disciplines.

WOMEN SENIOR are allowed to choose between Women and the Senior events.

If a category has 8 players or fewer, players may be allowed to compete in both the Parent category and the Child category, at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

In this case, the Tournament Director may choose one of the following formats:

- **OPTION 1:** Parent category: Qualification + Single Elimination

Child category: Single Elimination only (seeding for the Child category is based on the Parent category Qualification standings).

- **OPTION 2:** Child Category: Qualification + Single Elimination

The Child Category is played as a separate competition.

Any exceptional situations will be decided by the Tournament Director and communicated via Coral, as soon as possible after registration is close

ITSF LEAGUE: in case of 8 teams or less in one category, teams will play Joint qualifications and elimination in their own category

COMPETITION FORMATS

SWISS SYSTEM

All the qualification competitions will be played under the SWISS SYSTEM.

QUALIFICATION

The swiss system guarantees that at least 50% of players will qualify into the Main Division

PAIRING: The remaining players will be paired randomly. Subsequent rounds pair players based on their current score, with efforts made to pair players with similar scores against each other.

SCORING: Players earn points based on the results in the matches.

AVOIDING DUPLICATE PAIRINGS:

The Swiss system avoids pairing players against each other more than once

NUMBER OF ROUNDS: The qualifications continue for 4 rounds, with players accumulating points after each round

TIEBREAKERS

are determined by score, followed by:

- 1 / Buchholz score:** This score is the sum of the points of the opponents encountered during the qualification phase. The team with the highest score is ranked higher.
- 2 / Sonneborn-Berger score:** This is the sum of the points of defeated opponents only. The team with the highest score is ranked higher.
- 3 / Games difference:** This is the difference between the total number of games won and games lost by a team during the qualification phase. The team with the higher positive difference is ranked higher.
- 4 / Direct matches:** If the tied teams have played against each other, the winner of the direct encounter is ranked higher.
- 5 / Goals scores:** The total number of goals scored by a team in all matches. The team with the most goals scored is ranked higher.

FINAL AREA RULES

Players competing in the final area required to use the tablets provided to keep track of the score.

SEEDING

Seeded players/teams don't play qualifications.

SEEDING FOR ALL CATEGORIES IS 10% OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF TEAMS AND ALWAYS ROUNDING DOWN

Example: with 109 teams, 10% is 10.9, so only 10 teams are seeded.

Seeding is based on ITSF World Ranking and cannot be refused

ELIMINATION

100% of players will qualify for the elimination rounds in every competition

For all official individual categories, the tournament format varies based on the number of participating teams:

FOR 9 TO 31 TEAMS: Qualifications are held in a Swiss format with Bo3 matches, followed by the Main Division featuring Bo5 matches.

FOR 32 TEAMS AND ABOVE: Qualifications are conducted in a Swiss format with Bo3 matches, followed by the Main Division with Bo5 matches and the Second Division with Bo3 matches. Qualifying for the Main Division requires winning at least 2 matches.

We ask players to provide exact score to ensure accurate statistical data and to honor the public results that will be accessible in Coral.

DELAYS

If 9 mins after a game has been called, the game hasn't started and no recall has been made, both teams lose a set even if one team is present at the table. Similarly, they will lose 2 sets after 12 min.

After 15 mins, both teams will be eliminated.

ITSF WORLD CHAMPIONS LEAGUE



THE ITSF WORLD CHAMPIONS LEAGUE IS A MEN, WOMEN, SENIOR AND JUNIOR TEAM COMPETITION HELD ONCE AFTER THE END OF EACH SEASON. THE QUALIFYING EVENTS COUNT FOR THE ITSF WORLD CHAMPIONS LEAGUE 2026.

HOW TO CREATE MY TEAM

A team is formed of 3 to 9 players, each team must have a captain that acts like a club manager (the captain can be a playing members).

The club must be:

- Created and registered in Coral
- Tied to a city and a country
- All players need to be ITSF members

PLAYERS WILL DECLARE THEIR CLUB AFFILIATION UPON REGISTERING IN THE FIRST WCL EVENT THEY ATTEND.

A club can be represented by multiple teams.

- **Element 2** (Double 1) plays until one of the two formations has 10 points.
- **Element 3** (Single 2) plays until one of the two formations has 15 points. (No points difference)
- **Element 4** (Double 2) plays until one of the two formations has 20 points. (No points difference)

SUBSTITUTIONS

The team captain may make substitution during a match, which costs one time out per substitution session (if you replace both players in double, it only costs one time-out).

Substitutions can be made only after the first two elements have been played (S1 and D1)
Once substituted, a player is not permitted to return to the match.

RULES

A match is a race to 20 points (with no points difference) with a chain of four 5 goals steps (that is 4 elements).

These 4 elements are played S1,D1,S2,D2 by 3 to 6 different players. In case of less than 6 players: Player must play twice but the same player cannot play both Single elements and not both from the same section (S1+D1 or S2+D2)

In case of multitable format: 1 ball is player on the first table, then

HOW TO PLAY:

- 90 seconds between the elements to prepare the tables and to practice.
- Two time-outs of 45 seconds per element that cannot be saved for the following element.
- 1 ball is played on the first table, then players play 2 balls alternately on each table until the end of the match (tie break format)

SUBSTITUTIONS:

- The team captain may make substitutions, each costing one timeout
- Substitutions can be made only after the first two elements have been played (S1 and D1)
- Once substituted, a player is not permitted to return to the match.

COIN-FLIPS: One coin-flip shall precede the start of the match

The team that wins the coin flip has the choice of side of the table for all elements of that team or first serve. The team that loses has the remaining options.

Juniors and Girls who fulfill the U19 age requirements are permitted to participate in National events in their respective categories (Men/ Women) without any additional restrictions.

- Each team gets 2 timeouts per element

THE MATCH IS A RELAY

- **Element 1** (Single 1) plays until one of the two formations has 10 points.
- **Element 2** (Single 2) plays until one of the two formations has 20 points.
- **Element 3** (Double 1) plays until one of the two formations has 30 points. (No points difference)

Teams must keep track of score using Coral

SUBSTITUTIONS

The team captain may make substitution during a match, which costs one time out per substitution session (if you replace both players in double, it only cost one time-out).

- S1 can be substituted once one formation has reached 5 points
 - S2 can be substituted once one formation has reached 15 points
 - in D1 one or both of the players can be substituted once one formation has reached 25 points
- Once substituted, a player is not permitted to return to the match.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR YOUNGER PARTICIPANTS:

U13 and U16 Juniors and Girls are only allowed to participate in National events if explicit permission is granted by the ITSF Sport Commission. Contact: sport.commission@tablesoccer.org for request

REFEREE AND DRESS CODE

REFEREE

The tournament fee includes **5 €** for referee fees. Every referee is required to fill out a form after each match. Payment will be based on the organizer's referee commission rules and referee fees. Referees receive payment based on their level and number of matches officiated.

This fee does not guarantee a referee for your matches, but limited individual cost.

There is no refereeing during qualification rounds. During elimination rounds, if no referee is available after 9 minutes, the match must start.

ANTIDOPING

Even if we're not initiating anti-doping tests at this moment:

Play true - commit to sport that is free from doping

The current [list of prohibited](#) substances and methods is displayed on WADA's website.



ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED IN THE PLAYING AREA

Anyone caught drinking alcohol in the playing area will be fined 10 euros.

DRESS CODE

Players must wear proper sporting attire and are expected to uphold the highest level of personal and professional appearance.

The penalty for violating the dress code: being disqualified for the rest of the day

National team players need to wear the same jersey in the national team categories. Sport Dress is compulsory for ALL players during the competition including ceremonies. (Please refer to ITSF Dress Code [HERE](#) for details)
